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Directions: You must report for grand jury service unless you: (1) are **excused** from service under Article 19.25, Code of Criminal Procedure or (2) are **disqualified** from serving as a grand juror.

If you are excused: Circle the reason(s) for your excuse. Sign the form. Mail or take the form to the district clerk's office. NOTE: You may choose to serve even if you can be excused from service.

If you are Disqualified: Circle the qualification(s) that you do not meet. Sign the form. Mail or take the form to the district clerk. NOTE: If you claim to be disqualified because you are not a resident of this county, you may become ineligible to vote in this county. If you state that you are not a U.S. citizen, you may not be eligible to vote and may be required to provide proof of U.S. citizenship to your county voter registrar.

JUROR'S RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

RIGHT TO REEMPLOYMENT: An employer may not discharge, threaten to discharge, intimidate, or coerce any permanent employee because the employee serves as a juror, or for the employee's attendance or scheduled attendance in connection with the service, in any court in the United States. An employee who is discharged, threatened with discharge, intimidated, or coerced in violation of this section is entitled to return to the same employment that the employee held when summoned for jury service if the employee, as soon as practical after release from jury service, gives the employer actual notice that the employee intends to return. (Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Section 122.001).

PROPER CLOTHING REQUIRED: All persons entering the courtroom should be dressed in clothing reasonable befitting the dignity and solemnity of the court proceedings.

FAILURE TO ANSWER SUMMONS AND PROVISION OF FALSE INFORMATION: A person may be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 if the person fails to attend court in obedience to this summons without reasonable excuse. (Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 19.16).

EXCUSES FROM GRAND JURY SERVICE
(Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 19.25)

- 1. You are over 70 years of age.
 - 2. You are responsible for the care of a child younger than 18 years.
 - 3. You are a student at a public or private high school.
 - 4. You are enrolled and in actual attendance at an institution of higher education.
- Note: The court also may determine if a person has a reasonable excuse from service other than those listed above.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR GRAND JURY SERVICE
(Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 19.08)

- To be qualified to serve as a juror you must:
- 1. is at least 18 years of age;
 - 2. is a citizen of the United States;
 - 3. is a resident of this state, and of the county in which the person is to serve;
 - 4. is qualified under the Constitution and laws to vote in the county in which the grand jury is sitting, regardless of whether the person is registered to vote;
 - 5. is of sound mind and good moral character;
 - 6. is able to read and write;
 - 7. has not been convicted of misdemeanor theft or a felony;
 - 8. is not under indictment or other legal accusation for misdemeanor theft or a felony;
 - 9. is not related within the third degree of consanguinity or second degree of affinity, as determined under Chapter 573, Government Code, to any person selected to serve or serving on the same grand jury;
 - 10. has not served as grand juror in the year before the date on which the term of court for which the person has been selected as grand juror begins; and
 - 11. is not a complainant in any matter to be heard by the grand jury during the term of court for which the person has been selected as grand juror.
